## How to describe people, places or things

Cuando se trata de hacer descripciones en inglés, debemos asegurarnos de usar el verbo correcto para ello.

Podemos usar los verbos “**be**” y “**have/has**” para describir a alguien o algo. Ambos son usados de diferentes maneras, así que si quieres expresarte de la forma adecuada sigue las siguientes recomendaciones:

### Verb To Be

Puedes usarlo para describir tu estado y cómo te sientes. Por ejemplo:

- *How **are** you today? – I'm very well, thanks.*
- *We're hungry. **Is** there anything to eat?*
- *The kids **are** bored. Why don't we play a game?*
- *You're tired. You should go to bed.*

O para describir personas, lugares y cosas. Por ejemplo:

- *Paolo **is** tall and thin.*
- *Mr. and Mrs. Dean **are** really kind and friendly.*
- *What's the weather like? – **It's** cold and rainy...*
- *Your car **is** much faster than mine.*

### Verbo Have/Has

Este verbo es muy común en inglés porque se usa como verbo en varias situaciones y además como un auxiliar importante.

Puede significar:

- poseer o tener
- comer o beber
- coger o recibir
- hacer o experimentar algo
- hacer que algo suceda
- como verbo auxiliar para tiempos perfectos

Estructura

Es un verbo irregular. Aquí verás su estructura:

SINGULAR	PLURAL
I have	We have
You have	You have
He/she/it has	We have

Para hacer la forma negativa, agregamos “don’t/doesn’t ” como lo hacemos con todos los demás verbos, a excepción del verbo To Be.

I don't have	We don't have
You don't have	You don't have
He/she/it doesn't have	They don't have

Para hacer preguntas usamos “do/does”:

Do I have?	Do we have?
Do you have?	Do you have?
Does he/she/it have?	Do they have?

El verbo **have** (**has** para tercera persona: *he, she, it*) puede usarse para hacer descripciones, por ejemplo:

- You **have** two sisters, don't you?
- They **have** three factories in Poland.
- **Does he have** an apartment or a house?
- You **have** a great body!
- She **has** green eyes
- I **have** long arms.

- She's a young woman. She has got long, curly and brown hair. She's slim and medium height.
- She is wearing a beige blouse, grey trousers, with a brown belt and black shoes. She's also carrying a black handbag.
