| Subject | Afirmative | Negative |
|---------|------------|------------------|
| I | am | am not |
| You | are | are not / aren't |
| He | is | is not / isn't |
| She | is | is not / isn't |
| It | is | is not / isn't |
| We | are | are not / aren't |
| They | are | are not / aren't |

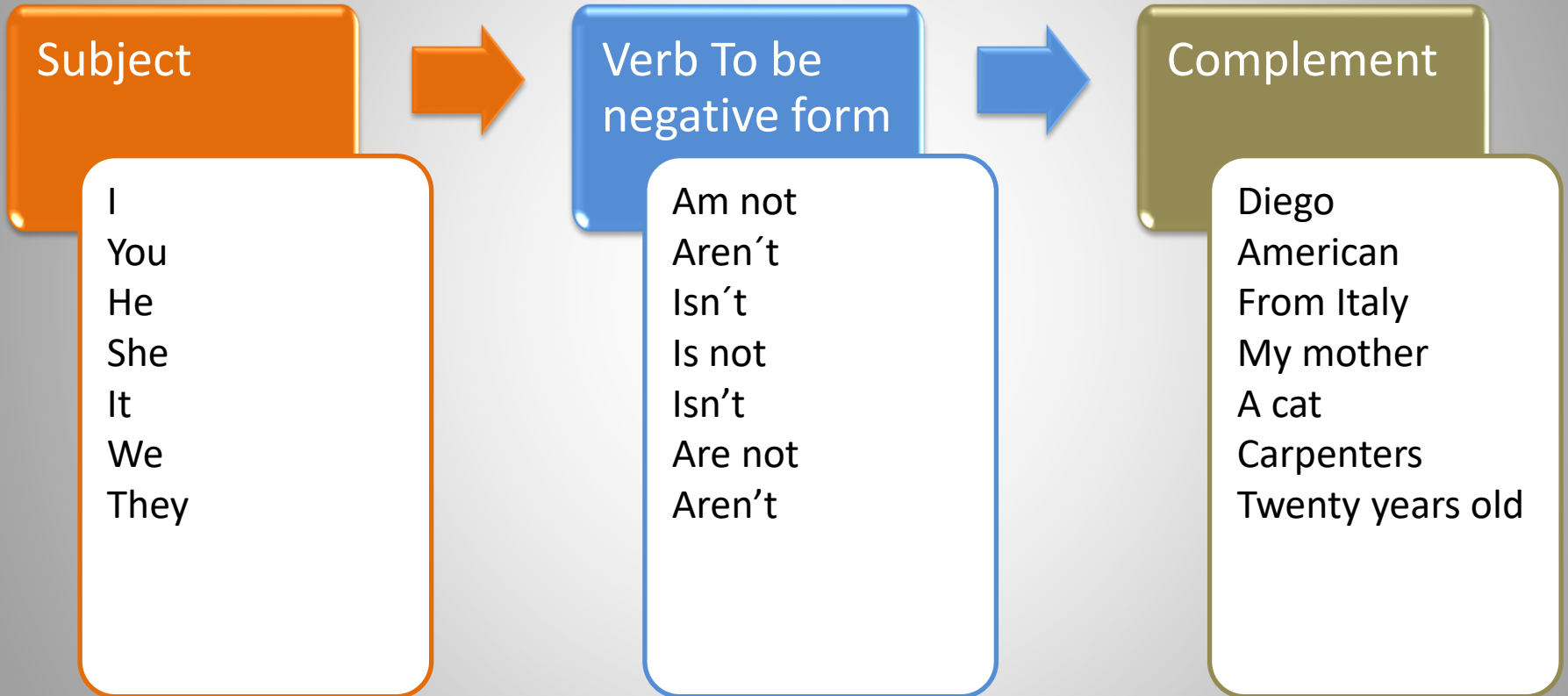
Some uses of the verb be are:

| Use | Example |
|--------------------------------|---------------------------------|
| To name things: | <i>This is a pen</i> |
| To describe a person's origin: | <i>I am from Mexico</i> |
| To describe location: | <i>The book is on the table</i> |
| To tell age: | <i>I am 15 years old</i> |

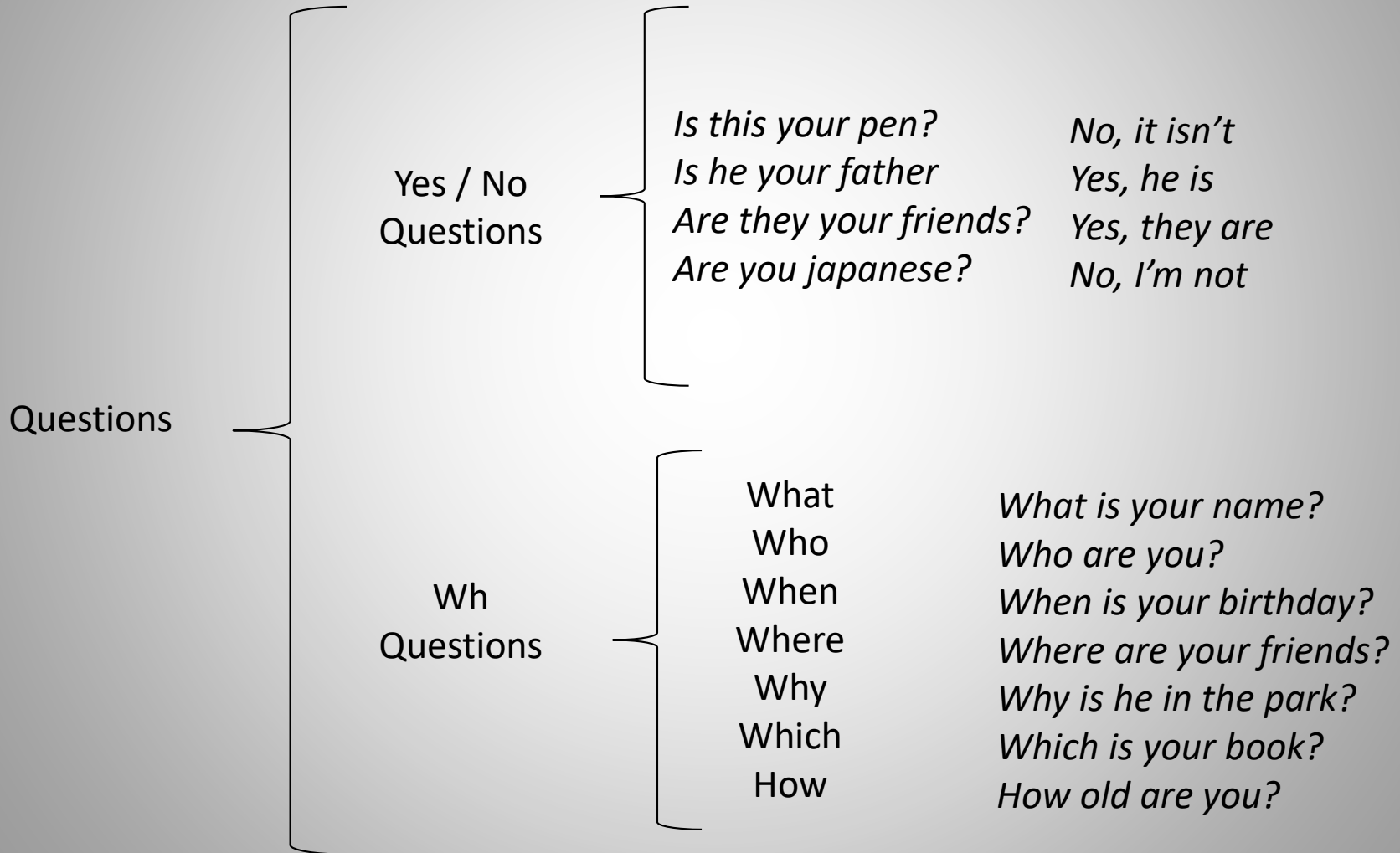
